#### *Grants and Fellowships*

On 20 February 2009 applications are due for the **2009 Michael Ventris Memorial Award for Mycenaean Studies** of up to £2000, to be awarded to postgraduate students or young scholars who have obtained a doctorate within the past five years in the field of Mycenaean civilization or kindred subjects, to promote research in (1) Linear B and other Bronze Age scripts of the Aegean and Cyprus and their historical and cultural connections, or (2) all other aspects of the Bronze Age of the Aegean and Cyprus.
