From the Editor:

The following suggestions grow out of the thoughtful comments by Robin Hägg concerning the technical difficulties non-American subscribers often encounter when paying in U.S. dollars.

The problem lies in the fact that we can not accept foreign currency drafts or checks; cashing them often costs us more than the amount they are written for. Thus, you as the subscribers are obliged to pay in U.S. dollars. There are several options to make this easier: 1) NESTOR accepts subscription fees for a maximum of three years at once and will not charge you retroactively for increases in subscription fees. 2) Several of our subscribers within the same country can buy an international money order together, thus splitting the administrative fee. 3) You can ask an American colleague known to you to pay for you in U.S. dollars with an American bank check and reimburse her/him in Europe or buy a book of equal value if that is acceptable.

In ALL cases, though, specify exactly for whom and for what length of time the subscription payment is. NESTOR grew out of a spirit of cooperation; by expanding it in this direction, life can be made easier for both NESTOR and its subscribers.

In the same vein, NESTOR carries announcements of upcoming events as early as possible, but NESTOR's limited space allows us ordinarily to carry announcements only once in their first form and a second time when the final program has been received. Significant changes of plan will be published, however. Presentations added during the conference or changes in topic will be announced after the proceedings. Should any pamphlets or circulars be distributed, NESTOR would much appreciate receiving a copy for its library.

The program encourages study of the Middle East, from prehistoric times to the modern era. The deadline for a student fellowship for doctoral research is October 31, 1986. The deadlines for other awards (e.g., post-doctoral) have passed. Due to our summer hiatus we were unable to publish these awards earlier.

J.W. Shaw, Director of the Kommos Excavations, kindly provided the following announcement: "Further to our most recent preliminary report (Hesperia, Fall, 1986) and in particular to interconnections between the harbour of Kommos in south central Crete and the Eastern Mediterranean, we would like to announce the discovery of New Kingdom Egyptian pottery at Kommos. The pottery is of grey-brown fabric, white-slipped, with flask and storage jar shapes. Over a dozen examples were identified by Dr. Eliezer Oren of Ben-Gurion University of the Negev who was especially invited to inspect what was already known to us to be eastern and mostly Canaanite, imported pottery. The Egyptian pottery occurs in the more important houses of the settlement and in the "civic" area in LMIII contexts. The future study of such pottery, along with Late Minoan pottery, by L.V. Watrous should add substantially to our knowledge of the role of Kommos and, by extension, of Crete in the East Mediterranean trade in the 14th and 13th centuries B.C."
