SELECTION PROCEDURES AND INSTRUCTIONS

The 1989 Archaeological Congress will be unique. Some fifteen thematic sessions will be held concurrently with standard individual society sessions. There are, therefore, two program committees for this special congress: 1) the Congress Program Committee is responsible for thematic sessions, and the 2) Society Program Committee is responsible for individual society sessions. The Congress Program Committee will organize only the thematic congress sessions (whereas each organization's program committee will separately oversee its own sessions). All members of participating societies will receive separate abstract forms for each type of session.

The Archaeological Congress, the first event of its kind in North America, attempts to transcend geographical, chronological, and disciplinary boundaries and address the broad philosophical and methodological questions raised by the study of past cultures. With this goal in mind, the Congress Program Committee, made up of representatives from each of the participating member societies, has selected the following topics for thematic sessions.

- 1) Ethnicity: How are groups recognized?
- 2) Landscape Archaeology: Environmental reconstruction and settlement patterns.
- 3) Archaeology and Politics: Political forces behind archaeology.
- 4) Underwater Archaeology: Recent explorations.
- 5) Collecting and the Role of Museums in Archaeology.
- 6) Archaeology and Text: Reconstruction of the past.
- 7) Colonization: Acculturation and trade.
- 8) Peopling the New World: When and how.
- 9) Dark Ages in Old and New World Archaeology: Applications and dimensions.
- 10) Diet and Food I: Trace-element, isotope and faunal analyses.
Diet and Food II: Cultural implications.
- 11) City Planning: Overview and case studies.
- 12) Death and Burial: Physical and cultural implications.
- 13) Preservation, Conservation and Restoration: Advances in techniques.
- 14) Materials Analysis: Contents of vessels.
- 15) Publishing: The purpose of excavation.
- 16) Archaeology in Education: Reaching the broader public.
- 17) Archaeology and the Public: Perception.

Frances Jones sent to me an article by James Barron in the February 16, 1987, New York Times about a Filipino cargo vessel which capsized in a North Atlantic storm:

"The Filipino vessell - the 345-foot Balsa 24, on her way from Savannah, Ga., to Algeciras, Spain - radioed an S O S at 1:30 P.M. Tuesday, according to a Coast Guard spokesman, Petty Officer Randy Midgett. The five-year-old ship had apparently been damaged by the storm and was in danger of sinking with her load of tons of clay, he said."

It must be economically feasible for Spain to import clay from Georgia in the U.S., even though Spain must have plenty of clay - think of all those Spanish tiles!

We are very sorry to report the death of our distinguished colleague, Prof. George E. Mylonas, at age 87, on April 16, 1988, in Athens after a brief illness.

The MICHAEL VENTRIS FUND was set up jointly in 1957 by the Institute of Classical Studies (University of London) and the Architectural Association to create an annual award in memory of Michael Ventris, who was killed in a road accident in 1956.

The Fund was created with the generous help of friends and fellow-workers. It has been given alternately to support projects in Mycenaean Greek studies and in architecture undertaken by scholars and architects on the threshold of promising careers in these fields.

Now, after 30 years, inflation has defeated the best efforts of the Trustees to maintain the purchasing power of the Award, though its value has risen over the years from £50 to £500. The Trustees are therefore appealing for further funds, in the hope of raising around £50,000. It is hoped that this would permit them to support a Greek and an architectural project every year.

SECOND SESSION OF THE "GROUPE DE CONTACT INTERUNIVERSITAIRE D'ETUDES CHYPRIOTES/INTERUNIVERSITAIRE CONTACTGROEP VOOR CYPRISCHE STUDIES"

The second worksession of the "Groupe de contact interuniversitaire d'études chypriotes/Interuniversitaire contactgroep voor Cyprische studies (National Foundation for Scientific Research) took place in Brussels at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel on Friday 29th of January 1988.

It started with a presentation by Mrs. Marguerite Yon, Directeur de Recherches au C.N.R.S., on "Chypre. Fouilles de Kition-Bamboula" in the presence of the Ambassador of the Republic of Cyprus and of the Rector of the Vrije Universiteit Brussel.

The afternoon was devoted to the Cypriote collections in Belgium. Mrs. Rina Margos presented 116 pieces from the Early Bronze Age to the Roman Period from the department of classical antiquities in the Royal Museums of Art and History at Brussels.

Mrs. Marijke Meekers commented on a loan from the Cyprus Museum by the Director of the Department of Antiquities of Cyprus, M. Vassos Karageorghis,

at the department of oriental antiquities of the Royal Museums: a stone axe and two sherds of the Neolithic Period, four sherds of the Chalcolithic Period, four vases of the Bronze Age, and five of the first millennium.

M. Guy Donnay presented items from the Early Bronze Age to the Medieval Period in the "Musée Royal de Mariemont."

Frieda Vandenabeele commented briefly on three limestone heads of the Classical Period, a jug of the Middle Bronze Age and one of the CG III or CA I Period in the Museum Mayer van den Bergh at Antwerp.

M. Eric Gubel noted seven items of the "Vleeshuismuseum" at Antwerp which belong to the Bronze Age.

M. Jan Driessen discussed the collection of the "Katholieke Universteit Leuven", in total twenty-two vases belonging to the Bronze and Iron Ages and two stone objects from the end of the Neolithic or the beginning of the Chalcolithic Period.

There also are a series of Base Ring jugs preserved in the store-rooms of the department of Egyptian antiquities of the Royal Museums of Art and History at Brussels, and a number of vases, also of the Late Bronze Age in the show-cases for the Palestinian region in the Royal Museums.

At the end of the day the assembly decided to publish this inventory. M. Paul Aström proposed to include it in the series of the Corpus of Cypriote Antiquities, Studies in Mediterranean Archaeology XX, which was unanimously accepted.

John Younger notes that "the major result of the conference as a whole was to document exceedingly well how rich the so-called transition period between Middle and Late Bronze Age really was...One interesting upshot was the conclusion by Carinci and La Rosa: after the disaster of ca. 1700 Phaistos began to rebuild but it seems that part-way through the rebuilding the Phaistians moved instead to Ayia Triada and remodeled it to serve as their bureaucratic center; when Phaistos was finished the Phaistians decided not to relocate the bureaucratic center back to Phaistos but to leave it at AT. This

deduction startled most of us and the discussion was lively but their belief held, and Weingarten, viewing the issue from the point of view of sealing practices, said it made perfect sense; so, perhaps it's right."

John added that six of the 34 papers, a sizable percentage, were read in absentia. Naturally, there were no discussions after absentee papers, nor was there the chance to see these people, hear them, and, if appropriate, ask them a few questions, which is what a conference is all about.

Here is a question for all Nestorites: How do you reconcile the evidence of the Geometric tripods of Odysseus found by Sylvia Benton on Ithaka with the much later date of the account of these tripods in the Odyssey? Did Homer know these tripods or of them and make up the story of the gifts of the Phaeacians, while the tripods themselves are a 'dedication' made to the memory of Odysseus about 800 B.C.? Is an alternative explanation possible? Could Homer's account, could Homer himself, be older than the tripods? Could the makers of these tripods and of the other Geometric monumental tripods of the 8th century have been inspired by Homer? Did Homer initiate the Greek Renaissance of the Eighth century?

News Briefs

Archaeologists working at Palaikastro, Crete have unearthed more fragments of a Minoan gold-and-ivory figurine whose torso and arms were first discovered last summer. The figurine originally stood 16 inches high and apparently shattered when it fell from a shrine during the conflagration that swept through the town around 1450 B.C. This summer, more than 100 new fragments were discovered with the aid of a water sieve; pieces include bits of gold leaf from the clothing, two ivory feet, an ivory ear, and a stone head.
