## COMMUNICATIONS

From Lord William Taylour there is the news that in the 1960 excavations within the Acropolis of Mycenae there were found eight fragments of tablets. These are numbered 701-708, four fairly legible as far as they are preserved, and uniform in subject matter, three of increasing difficulty, and one uninscribed.

Two errors in <u>KT</u> I and II, brought to my attention by E. Grumach: Db1140, read RAM 165 EWE 35; Dv5273 was joined to 1214 in 1954 and should be cancelled.
