J. Chadwick has prepared a preliminary list of addenda to A. Morpurgo's Mycenaeae Graecitatis Lexicon arising from KT<sup>3</sup>. Mimeographed copies of this list may be obtained on request from the Institute for Research in the Humanities.

The discovery of Linear B tablets in Thebes, reported by Evi Touloupa in Kadmos with photographic illustration, is greeted with pleasure and the anticipation of more. We may, in what has become our customary practice, identify this fragment as TH X 1 (TH for Thebes, X for the class of indeterminate texts, and 1 for the first to be published). We hope that this numeration will not conflict, but rather will agree with that to be adopted when the whole collection is published. For its reading, which does seem very clear in the photograph, one can only agree with H. Mühlestein's comments, which follow.
