Ethnos, 6, 16 February 1970, V. Konstantinopoulos. Traces of an Early Helladic settlement were found near the Tomb of Marathon.

Eleftheros Kosmos, 7 Feb. 1970, Minas Nisiotis. Excavations at Fotolivos.

Eleftheros Kosmos, 15 Feb. 1970, Minas Nisiotis. The chronology of the appearance of Cyclopean walls, according to S. Iakovidis.

Ethnos, 28 Feb. 1970. The threat to the Palace of Nestor and to the ancient Stadium at Olympia from the rain.

To Vima, 1 Mar. 1970, E P. From the Dymaian Wall, an Early Helladic stone idol and Mycenaean pottery give evidence of cult from pre-Hellenic times.

To Vima, 3 May 1970, T. S. Tarousis. Mycenaean pottery at the Temple of Poseidon at Isthmia.

Eleftheros Kosmos, 9 May 1970, Miltis Paraskevaidis. Discoveries of the University of Minnesota explorations at Nikhoria in Messenia.

To Vima, 17 May 1970, Jerome J. Pollitt; Robert S. Brumbaugh. Discussion of the destruction of Thera, and of theories of Atlantis.

Ta Nea, 21 May 1970. A Mycenaean chamber tomb has been found at Armenokhori in Astypalaia. Although it was robbed, quantities of metal as well as ceramic objects remain.
