Apoyevmatini, 17 October 1970, Laz. Arseniou; Eleftheros Kosmos, 18 October 1970. Road work at Larisa led to the discovery of a Middle Helladic tomb with a skeleton, two pots, and a bronze ring.

Ta Nea, 3 November 1970. A Bronze Age necropolis is found at Haghia Eirini, near Kyrenia in Cyprus. Among the finds were seal-cylinders, and two Egyptian pots, one of which shows a double axe.

Estia, 7 November 1970. New discoveries at Arkhanes, under the direction of A. Lembesi, include a clay model of a Minoan house, and a tablet with a Linear A inscription. The house has a propylon, light-well, barred windows, internal partitions with columns, doors, and a stairway to the roof.

Ta Nea, 10 November 1970. G. Mylonas spoke to the Athenian Academy about "The origin of the Mycenaean civilization." Frescoes from the summit of the city were shown, and further new excavations were promised.

Eleftheros Kosmos, 26 November 1970, M. Paraskevaidis. Account of the new excavations at Akrotiri, Thera. Among other finds there are many with one or two signs, and one with a complete word of four signs of Linear A. The frescoes found are outstanding.

CORRESPONDENCE

To the Editor: - Would it be possible through Nestor to encourage archaeologists and chemists together to use the thermoluminescence-method for the purpose of dating the Linear B tablets from Knossos? As the problem of the dating of the Knossos tablets is still not satisfactorily solved, some aid might be found in this new way of dating ceramics--especially if the results are compared with similar investigations on the Pylos tablets.

I have asked the leading Danish expert on that subject, Mr. V. Mejdahl from the Danish Atomic Energy Commission Research Establishment Risø Roskilde (see e.g. his articles in Archaeometry). To quote his letter to me, "it should be possible to say something about the age of these tablets." Further, Mr. Mejdahl tells me that if the project could be carried through, he would be willing and quite interested to cooperate.
