Eleftheros Kosmos, ca. 5 May 1971, Miltis Paraskevaidis; Ta Nea, 5 May 1971; Wisconsin State Journal (UPI), 5 May 1971; Times (London) 6 May 1971. At Thebes a rectangular chamber tomb of the Mycenaean period has been found, under the direction of T. Spyropoulos. At several points on the walls of the tomb are fresco paintings including women, landscape, and papyrus ornament. From a burial (apparently of a woman) comes a cylindrical pyxis with four sphinxes.
