CORRESPONDENCE

To the Editor: - The letters of John Chadwick and Yves Duhoux suggest that it is time to close this correspondence. It would be fair if the initiator did no more than bring out the main points of difference.

I sought a single explanation of a constellation of facts: the PY Ab rations and their correlations with MULIER kowa kowo TA and DA, the PY Fn accounts, the internal ratios of the system of dry capacity measurements, the Mesopotamian analogies, and the deduced capacity of a MU which affords an opportunity of linking up with the archaeological evidence. This explanation I found in the determination of GRANUM V 1 as the daily ration of a DA, equal to that of a craftsman in the Fn accounts.

Dr. Chadwick (followed by M. Duhoux) bases his calculations on KN Am 819. Important for the interpretation of this text are 1) that KN distinguishes a DA from a VIR, 2) that PY Ab gives a figure for a DA and not a VIR, 3) that PY Fn shows that a slave got half the rations of a craftsman, 4) that there is a conversion rate of 2:1 for barley:wheat. It follows that a slave got HORDEUM V 30 per month.

This insight was applied to Am 819 as long ago as 1964, and it was repeated in an earlier letter. M. Duhoux overlooks the vital 1) and 2). Both scholars are forced into non-equations: KN DA ≠ PY DA ≠ TH DA, and KN kowo ≠ PY kowo. I asked for justification. Dr. Chadwick has postponed his answer. I asked M. Duhoux how his statement that a Mycenaean kowo got the same rations as an adult squared with the PY evidence that he got half the woman's ration. I receive no answer.
