Announcement

If the Committee indicates an interest in the submission, two copies of the complete manuscript will be required for review. The AIA *Monographs, New Series* will commence with the publication of *The Entrance to the Athenian Acropolis Before Mnesicles*, by Harrison Eiteljorg, II, the result of his excavation in 1975 of the pre-Mnesiclean entrance to the Acropolis and of further studies of the area in 1987 and 1989.
