Past Lectures and Conferences

A symposium, "The Spoils of War--World War II and Its Aftermath: The Loss, Reappearance, and Recovery of Cultural Property", sponsored by The Bard Graduate Center for Studies in the Decorative Arts, took place January 19-21, 1995 in New York City. Speakers included representatives of government and museum organizations in countries that suffered losses; officials that participated in the collecting, documentation, and dispersal of displaced property during the war; and experts in the field of art law.
