Past Lectures and Conferences

Dr. Anna Michailidou spoke on “Exploring the Function of Upper Storeys in the Settlement of Akrotiri on Thera” at the Institute of Fine Arts in New York as part of **The New York Bronze Age Colloquium** series on May 8, 1997.

In celebration of the 90th anniversary of the founding of the **St. Louis Chapter of the Archaeological Institute of America** a symposium entitled “At Home in the Ancient World: Domestic Life in the Mediterranean World from the Beginnings of Urbanization to the High Roman Empire” was held on April 25-26, 1997 at the St. Louis Art Museum and Washington University.

At Harvard University on April 8-12, 1997 the **Near Eastern Languages and Civilizations Department** held a seminar on the Late Bronze-Iron Age transition on Cyprus chaired by Larry Stager and including presentations by Marion Feldman (“Continuity and Change in Cultural Traditions in LB-Iron Age Syria-Palestine: The Evidence from Ancient Art”) and Michael Sugeran (“Canaanite Jars: Analytical Evidence for Their Manufacture and Distribution”).
