Announcements

Malcolm Wiener, President of the Board of the Institute for Aegean Prehistory (INSTAP), was awarded an honorary degree from the University of Tübingen in Germany on 23 October 1998. The doctorate was the first honorary degree awarded by the University in three years and the first ever to a prehistorian. On 20 November 1998, Dr. Wiener was also awarded an honorary degree by the University of Athens. The accompanying citations noted Dr. Wiener's contributions to the preservation of sites and publication of the research of others, as well as his own scholarly contributions to Mediterranean prehistory and Bronze Age chronology. Dr. Wiener has also recently been elected a Corresponding Member of the Austrian Archaeological Institute, a Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries in London, and a Vice President of the British School at Athens. A conference on Cypriot White Slip pottery was also held in his honor in Nicosia, Cyprus, on 29-30 October 1998. The Editors of *NESTOR* would like to congratulate Dr. Wiener on all of his recent awards and overall accomplishments.
