On 21-23 November 2002 an International Round Table will be held on the theme of **Mythos: La préhistoire égéenne du XIX<sup>e</sup> au XXI<sup>e</sup> siècle après J.-C.** at the École française in Athens, sponsored by the École française d'Athènes, the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique, and the Université de Paris I. The conference will address fundamental questions concerning the history of archaeological research in the Aegean and neighboring regions including Anatolia, Cyprus, and the Balkans considering archaeological discovery, the reception of archaeological finds and interpretations, and overcoming public and academic stereotypes. Papers may be presented in English, French, or Greek. M. Tsipopoulou and P. Warren have invited short papers for inclusion in a volume stemming from their workshop at the recently concluded 9<sup>th</sup> International Cretological Congress entitled **Social structure and political organization of Late Prepalatial Crete**. Papers should discuss the characteristics and the dynamics of the island society in the periods which preceded the emergence of the first palaces (EMIII and MMIA), during which there is now ample evidence for signs of growing socio-political complexity, significant changes in patterns of material culture, new forms of religion and symbolic behavior, and clear indications of narrower spheres of influence. Papers should address questions leading to:

- better understanding of the spatial and chronological patterning of the archaeological and the architectural data sets;
- suggestions for possible models of socio-polical and socio-economic organization during the late Prepalatial period;
- proposals for patterns of symbolic and religious behavior that the emergent elites used to manipulate communal actions.

Paper submissions (6 pages maximum with references in the text, excluding references cited and illustration captions), in Greek, English, French, Italian, or German, are due by 15 January 2002 in both hard copy and on diskette including the paper, references, and captions in Word 97, with all illustrative materials in publication-ready format (2 pages maximum of tables, graphs, plans, or drawings; a map of Crete with all sites and geographical features mentioned in any paper will be supplied by the editors.) Materials should be sent to Dr. Metaxia Tsipopoulou, Voulgaroktonou 68, Athens 114.73, Greece. Peer review including review by Tsipopoulou and Warren, critical specialist commentary, and authors' comments and rebuttals is scheduled to take a total of six weeks leading to circulation by September/October 2002. The volume will

include an introductory essay by the organizers and a concluding critical overview essay by a non-Cretan specialist surveying the collection of papers and offering critical comments for future directions of research.
