### *Call for Papers*

The editors of *Aegean Archaeology* are soliciting submissions of field reports, synthetic studies, theoretical papers, notes, book reviews, and review articles that concern the Aegean world from the Neolithic through the Early Iron Age-Archaic material cultures. Submissions are also welcomed in areas impinging physically, culturally, or theoretically on the Aegean realm and in periods peripheral to the main chronological focus, if their contents are directly and substantially relevant to the focal regions and periods. The editors welcome especially reports presenting the results of any stage of fieldwork for more rapid publication than is possible in most other journals.

Manuscripts should be in English written on Microsoft Word, and may be accompanied by black-and-white illustrations for print publication; beginning next autumn the editors of *Aegean Archaeology* expect to be able to publish via the internet high quality 35 mm color slides of artifacts and physical contexts at three resolutions (600x400, 1200x800, and 1800x1200 dots per inch) suitable for detailed study and archive purposes (supported by *Apollo: An Infrastructure for Teaching the Ancient Mediterranean and Medieval Worlds* [<http://apollo.classics.unc.edu>] in the Digital Library Resource of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill). *Aegean Archaeology* does not restrict the number of either pages or illustrations. All submissions are refereed by at least two specialist readers.
