Grants and Fellowships

On 1 December 2008 applications are due for the following fellowship to the **American School of Classical Studies at Athens (ASCSA)** for the academic year 2009–2010:

NEH Fellowships: for postdoctoral scholars and professionals in the humanities, who must be U.S. citizens or foreign national U.S. residents for three years before the application deadline and must hold their Ph.D. or equivalent terminal degree; up to \$40,000.

On 1 December 2008, 1 April 2009, and 1 September 2009 applications are due for the following fellowships:

Wiener Laboratory Research Associateships: for well-defined research projects at the laboratory; up to \$7,000.

Wiener Laboratory Travel Grants for Archaeological Science Research in Greece: travel grants for graduate students or postdoctoral scholars from North American institutions working on projects in archaeological science in Greece; \$2,000.

On 15 January 2009 applications are due for both memberships to ASCSA and the following fellowships for which students and scholars of Aegean prehistory may be eligible:

Regular Program Membership: for graduate students in classical studies and ancient Mediterranean studies and related fields (e.g., history of art, anthropology, prehistory, etc.), who, preferably, have completed at least one year of graduate work; up to 13 predoctoral fellowships are offered for the Regular Academic Program with \$11,500 plus room and board at Loring Hall on the grounds of ASCSA and waiver of ASCSA fees.

Student Associate Membership: Advanced graduate students in the same fields as for Regular Membership who plan to pursue independent research projects, and who do not wish to commit to the full Regular Program.

Summer Sessions Membership: Two six-week sessions explore the sites and museums in Greece. Open to graduate and undergraduate students and to high school and college teachers. The fee of \$3,675 includes tuition, travel within Greece, room, and partial board. Scholarships are available.

The Jacob Hirsch Fellowship: for a PhD candidate or a recent PhD from the U.S. or Israel whose dissertation or research project requires a lengthy residence in Greece; \$11,500 plus room, board, and waiver of ASCSA fees.

Solow Dissertation Research Fellowships: Travel Fellowships for advanced Ph.D. candidates working on dissertations in Greece related to ancient art and architecture up to \$1,500 per month for up to two months.

Wiener Laboratory Fellowships: for graduate students or postdoctoral scholars working on well-defined projects in skeletal, faunal, geoaerchaeological, or environmental studies; \$15,500 to \$27,000.

Mellon (East European) Research Fellowships: for scholars from Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, and Slovakia in any field of classical studies or post-classical studies.

On 16 January 2009 applications are due for:

CAORC Multi-Country Research Fellowships: for Ph.D. candidates and senior scholars whose research has regional significance and requires travel to several countries, at least one of which hosts an American overseas research center; up to \$9,000. Getty Research Exchange Fellowships (CAORC): for scholars who are Greek citizens and who have already obtained a Ph.D or have professional experience in the study or preservation of cultural heritage, who wish to undertake a specific research project at an American overseas research center in another country, and who must affiliate with one of the approved overseas research centers in the Mediterranean Basin and Middle East: up to \$3,000 for no less than one month for living expenses and up to \$1,000 for travel expenses. On 19 February 2009 applications are due for:

School Advanced Fellowships: for students who have completed the Regular Program or one year as a Student Associate Member; \$11,500 plus room, board, and waiver of ASCSA fees.

On 15 March 2009 applications are due for:

CAORC Coulson/Cross Aegean Exchange Program: for Greek nationals and scholars to pursue research in Turkey under the auspices of the American Research Institute in Turkey (ARIT): \$250 per week plus round-trip airfare (short term). Application should be made to ASCSA.

There is no deadline for application for Senior Associate Membership: for postdoctoral scholars with suitable research projects. Application should be made to the Director in Athens.

Residence at CAARI is required for the Swiny and O'Donovan Fellows; the Parks fellow will reside at CAARI while in Nicosia, and will additionally give a presentation at CAARI on a subject related to his/her research and will periodically keep the Director of CAARI apprised of his/her research activities.
