Grants and Fellowships

On 1 November 2009 applications are due for the following fellowships from the **Archaeological Institute of America** (AIA) for the academic year 2010–2011:

Olivia James Traveling Fellowship: for students who are U.S. citizens with preference to those doing research toward a PhD or who are recent recipients (within 5 years of the application deadline) of a PhD, to travel and study in Greece, the Aegean Islands, Sicily, Southern Italy, Asia Minor, Mesopotamia; \$25,000.

Harriet and Leon Pomerance Fellowship: for citizens or permanent residents of the U.S or Canada, or students actively pursuing an advanced degree at a North American college or university, who have not previously held a Pomerance Fellowship, for an individual project of a scholarly nature related to Aegean Bronze Age Archaeology: \$5,000.

Publication Preparation Grant: for graduate students and postdoctoral professionals to support completion and publication of field research in a peer-reviewed outlet by assisting in the final analysis and writing of the results of field research so that, by the end of the second year, a completed manuscript may be submitted for publication: \$5,000 over 2 years.

Publication Subvention Grant: preference for first-time authors and/or final reports of excavated or surveyed sites as yet unpublished, to support new book-length publications in the field of Classical Archaeology (defined as Greek, Roman, and Etruscan archaeology and art history), by nominations submitted from eligible non-profit publishers such as university or museum presses: typically \$5,000, but may vary.

APA/AIA Minority Scholarship: for minority (African American, Hispanic-American, Asian-American, and Native American) undergraduates, to further preparation for graduate work in classics or classical archaeology; applications must be sent to the American Philological Association (http://www.apaclassics.org/); \$3,000 maximum.

On 15 January 2010 applications are due for:

Anna C. and Oliver C. Colburn Fellowship: for citizens or permanent residents of the U.S or Canada who are pre-doctoral or recent recipients (within 5 years of the application deadline) of a PhD, to support studies at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens, Greece, for no more than a year; must apply concurrently to the ASCSA for Associate Membership or Student Association Membership; \$11,000 (offered every two years).

On 15 March 2010 applications are due for:

Jane C. Waldbaum Archaeological Field School Scholarship: for junior and senior undergraduates, and 1st year graduate students who are currently enrolled in a U.S. or Canadian college or university and who have not previously participated in an archaeological excavation, to support participation in an archaeological excavation or survey project; \$1,000.

Kress History of Art: Institutional Fellowships: for PhD candidates (U.S. citizen or matriculating at a U.S. university) working on a doctoral dissertation in architecture, art history, archaeology, and classical studies, with dissertation research focusing on European art from antiquity to the early 19th century. Candidates must be nominated by their art history department; for a two-year research appointment in association with a foreign institute, including the American Research Institute in Turkey (ARIT) in Ankara, the Nelson Glueck School of Biblical Archaeology or the W. F. Albright Institute of Archaeological Research in Jerusalem, and the Cyprus American Archaeological Research Institute (CAARI) in Nicosia; \$22,500 per year.

Kress History of Art: Travel Fellowships: for PhD candidates (U.S. citizen or matriculating at a U.S. university) working on a doctoral dissertation in art history, with dissertation research focusing on European art before 1900. Candidates must be nominated by their art history department; \$3500 to \$10,000.
