(b1) Party 1

 $|^{1}$ From Ammonios, the son of Ammonios, of the deme of Althaea, and $|^{2}$ from his wife, Semele, the daughter of Ammonios, $|^{3}$ a citizen, with as guardian Ammonios himself

(b2) Party 2

Concerning the points at issue, $|^{6}$ we agree with one another on the following conditions $|^{7}$ such that, since Ammonios and $|^{8}$ Semele have handed over $|^{9}$ their daughter Ammonarion, $|^{10}$ being of age, to Artemidoros as husband for a joint life,

(d) Considerans about the receipt of the dowry by the husband
