Contract for the return of a payment made for a slave intended as a gift (*synchoresis*) October 23, 5 BC

(a) *Adressee* |¹ To Protarchos,

(b1) *Party 1* |² from Himeros, the son of Ptolemaios, of the deme of Zeus,

(b2) *Party 2* and from |³ Quintus Caecilius Kastor.

(c) Considerans

Since Quintus happens |⁴ to have received from his patron, |⁵ Quintus Caecilius Oinogenes, abroad, ¹⁶ to deliver to Himeros here (*in Alexandria*) as a gift the slaves Philetairos, Phaithros, |⁷ Bassos, and Vitulus (*crossed out*: and Optatus), |⁹ but the shipment was made by mistake in the name of Quintus |¹⁰ Caecilius Kastor himself, |¹¹ and he transferred by deed |¹² to Himeros without taking any payment in the |¹³ 23rd year of Caesar (*Augustus*) through the |¹⁴ notarial office the four slaves listed and yet another slave, Optatus, after having been paid for Optatus by banker's draft |¹⁵ through the bank of Asklepiades |¹⁶ (*crossed out*: Sarapion) 1,200 silver drachmas,

(d) Return of payment for one slave

 $|^{17}$ Himeros now agrees $|^{18}$ that he has received from Quintus Caecilius Kastor $|^{19}$ through the same bank of Asklepiades (*crossed out*: Sarapion) the $|^{20-21}$ 1,200 drachmas paid to him (*Kastor*) by banker's draft for Optatus, $|^{29}$ because Optatus was sent to Himeros by $|^{30}$ Oinogenes as a gift, $|^{23}$ (*crossed out*: and) he agrees that neither he nor anyone else on his behalf will proceed against Quintus $|^{24}$ Caecilius Kastor concerning these things or the confirmation (*of the transfer*) $|^{25}$ of the five slaves in any way, $|^{26}$ or else, apart from the fact that the things agreed upon are effective, $|^{27}$ Himeros agrees that, when he transgresses (*any of these provisions*), he is liable to the damages and the statutory penalty (*to the state*).
