# (c) Agreement proper

|<sup>4</sup> We agree on the following terms: Tryphon agrees that he has received from those |<sup>5</sup> around Amyntas, who are each other's guarantors, the monthly payments they have to pay for the |<sup>6</sup> remaining months of the *eranos* loan of ten drachmas per monthly installment they took up ... in accordance with |<sup>7</sup> a letter drawn up by a notary in the 19th year of Caesar (*Augustus*) ... |<sup>8</sup> and that the indicated contract is ineffective, |<sup>9</sup> and those around Amyntas agree that the autograph receipt of the (*first*) installment, |<sup>10</sup> which Tryphon advanced, is obsolete |<sup>11</sup> ... because of the fact that it has been paid off, and they also agree that they have received this (*receipt*), and Tryphon agrees that he will not |<sup>12</sup> proceed, nor anyone else on his behalf, against |<sup>13</sup> any of the aforementioned matters concerning ... and those around |<sup>14</sup> Amyntas agree that they will not proceed against Tryphon concerning ... |<sup>15</sup> ... they will remove at their own expense (*anyone else who does*),

or else they agree  $|^{16}$  ... as a favor along with half as much again,  $|^{17}$  and apart from the fact that the things agreed upon are effective,  $|^{18}$  they agree that they are liable to the damages and expenses and the statutory  $|^{19}$  penalty (to the state).
