and from Lyka, the daughter  $|^3$  of Zoilos, a Persian, with as guardian her husband, Dionysios, the son of Ptolemaios,  $|^4$  a Persian of the *epigone*, and from Dionysios himself.

#### (c) Agreement proper

Lyka and Dionysios agree  $|^5$  that they have received from Achilleus in cash  $|^6$  and not through a bank as a loan 310 Ptolemaic silver drachmas,  $|^7$  over which they agree that they will pay as interest eight obols per 100 drachmas per  $|^8$  month from Hathyr of the current 27th year  $|^9$  of Caesar (*Augustus*), and they agree that they will pay back the sum in three months starting from the same  $|^{10}$  month without any delay,

# (d) Penalty clause

or else they agree that they are immediately liable to seizure,  $|^{11}$  or the one of them who will be available, and can be held until they  $|^{12}$  pay back the loan along with half as much again and the basic interest (*without half as much again*)  $|^{13}$  and for the time that has passed (*the deadline*) the two drachmas (*per 100 drachmas per month*) interest in accordance with the statute,  $|^{14}$  while the right of execution (*of the claim*) belongs to Achilleus from the debtors  $|^{15}$  who are each other's guarantors for payment and from one of them whom he  $|^{16}$  chooses and from all their belongings just as if by virtue of a legal decision,  $|^{17}$  while all safe-conducts (*and*) every kind of protection they adduce  $|^{18}$  are ineffective.
